### Pay Your bill on Line

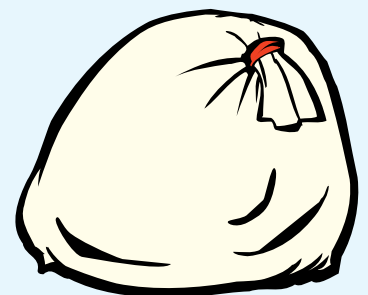
- Sign up to view your bill on-line as well as make a payment. It's easy! Go to [www.myvvs.com](http://www.myvvs.com) and sign up.

## AB1826 - Mandatory Commercial Organic Recycling

AB1826 requires businesses that generate 4 cubic yards of organic waste per week to arrange for organic waste recycling services. For those businesses that are currently out of compliance with AB1826 legislation, the City's FOG inspectors will be providing businesses with useful information on how to comply with the Bill during their annual inspections. ## Did you know... **AB 341 State Requirement to Recycle**

AB341 requires Multi-Family complexes with 5 or more units and businesses that generate 4 cubic yards or more of trash per week to arrange for recycling services:

- ⇒ **Your business is eligible for low-cost recycling pick-up services from VVS.**
- ⇒ **Recycling isn't just good for the environment, it can save businesses money.**
- ⇒ **Up to half of what is thrown away can be recycled. By recycling, your business can divert resources away from landfills and into manufacturing new products.**
- ⇒ **By signing up for recycling services and reducing your garbage container size or frequency of pick-up, you can reduce your VVS bill every month.**



## Reduce Recycling Contamination

Recycling contamination occurs when non-recyclable items are mixed in with recyclable items or when recyclable items are placed in the wrong containers. Contaminated recyclables have limited value and run the risk of being unnecessarily landfilled. - ✓ Keep foods and liquids out of recycling cars and bins.
- ✓ Recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.
- ✓ Purchasing products made from recycled materials helps to preserve our natural resources.

### Recycling Don'ts

- ✗ Do not recycle pizza boxes that contain oils or food waste.
- ✗ Do not place electronic devices in your recycling container.
- ✗ Food soiled containers, paper plates and napkins should be disposed of in the trash.
