Waste Disposal Discounts

The City of La Puente and Valley Vista Disposal Services has partnered up to offer two Waste Disposal Discounts to La Puente Residents that live in a single family residence. The two discount programs

are the Extremely Low-Income Waste Disposal Discount and the Senior Citizen Waste Disposal Discount. Extremely Low Income Waste Disposal Discount: Extremely low-income families

are eligible for a 50% rate reduction in residential waste collection services. Applicants must be below annual income limits specified below based on family household size to qualify:

Senior Citizen Waste Disposal Discount: This is available to qualified senior citizens for either a 10% discount that are maintaining the 100-gallon trash container or a 25% discount for residents that switch

to a smaller 70-gallon trash container. Applicants must be a senior citizen sole occupant or senior citizen couple occupant of the residence for which a rate reduction is requested. The applicant must be 60

years of age or older. Proof of age will be required. If you wish to apply for either of these programs or if you have any questions, please contact City Hall at (626) 855-1500.

E-Libraries Coming to Hacienda La Puente Unified School District

Hacienda La Puente Unified School District in the 2017-18 school year will provide all District students access to an online library through Overdrive and a Los Angeles County Consortium. HLPUSD was the first district in the Los Angeles County Consortium to enter the agreement for an online library that will provide students access to a wide range of e-books available on any electronic device such as a computer, tablet, smartphone or e-reader. The District will also provide each school with a set of Kindle Fire e-readers that students may check out from the library. Internet connection is needed only to checkout and download the book for reading. This can

be done at school or any local free Wi-Fi hotspot. Book titles will be available in English, Spanish, and Mandarin.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Collection

The City will be hosting a free Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Event operated by the County of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts on **Saturday, July 8, 2017 from 9 am to 3 pm at La Puente Park located at 501 N. Glendora Avenue.** This event gives La Puente and Los Angeles County residents a legal, safe and easy way to dispose of unwanted household chemicals, paints, cleaners, motor oil, pesticides, electronic waste (e-waste) and used needles. There is a limit of 15 gallons or 125 pounds of haz-

ardous waste per vehicle trip. No appointment is needed. **The following items will not be accepted:**

HHW and e-waste from businesses.

Explosives, ammunition, and radioactive materials.

Trash and tires.

White goods (refrigerators, stoves, washing machines, etc.)

2. All fees must be paid at the time of registration. Checks must be made payable to the City of La Puente. Valid California driver's license or identification is required. There will be a \$25 charge on all returned checks, and participants will not be allowed to attend class(es) until payment is made. Returned check charges and registration fees must be paid in cash at City Hall.

3. Only registered participants will be allowed to participate in class/activity. A


minimum of 10 participants is needed for all classes or they will be cancelled due to low participation. It is important for participants to be in class at their scheduled time and also to be picked up on time.

4. A \$5.00 service fee is charged for all refunds issued. No refunds will be given after the second class date unless the class is cancelled by the Recreation Services Department. Original receipts are required for all refunds. Refunds will be issued by check and mailed to the participant. Please allow 4 weeks for checks to be received.

CITY OF LA PUENTE BUSINESS LICENSE INFORMATION

The City of La Puente is pleased to have you in our community. We are proud to support our business community with professional services. An essential part of providing you with excellent professional service is ensuring that all businesses have the right tools to open their business in our City. This article has been prepared to give you an overview of the basic requirements to establish and operate a business in the City of La Puente. Additional information may be obtained by contacting the City of La Puente at 626-855-1500.

Who needs a Business License: Per La Puente Municipal Code Section 5.04.140, any individual, partnership, or sole proprietor who wishes to conduct business within the City of La Puente MUST secure a business license. A separate license is required for each type of business at one location or for a different location. Any person claiming or requesting an exemption shall file a sworn statement with the Business License Division stating the facts upon which the exemption is claimed and provide a copy of the exemption.

Out of town license: Even if you do not have a physical location in the City of La Puente you are still required to obtain a business license. You may obtain an out of town application at City Hall or by logging into the City's website at <http://www.lapuente.org>

Home Occupations: Per La Puente Municipal Code Section 5.04.160, "A home occupation permit pursuant to Section 10.50.110 must be obtained before a license will be issued for a business conducted at or from a place of residence."

Business Advertisement: A special permit must be obtained to place a banner on the premises and for outdoor promotional sales. Please Contact the Planning Department at 626-855-1538 to obtain more information.

Posting and Modification of a Business License: All business license certificates shall be posted in a conspicuous place upon the premises where the business is conducted. To amend a business name, location, address or change of ownership, it is the owner's responsibility to provide written notification of such changes to the business license division.

Transfer of Liability: Per La Puente Municipal Code Section 5.04.240 "Business Licenses are not transferable." If the structure of your business has changed please notify the City immediately to obtain a new business license.

Business Closure: Notify the City if you have closed your business. Your license will remain active until notification is received.

Retail Businesses: You must apply for a sellers permit with the State Board of Equalization. For more information please call 626-480-7200.



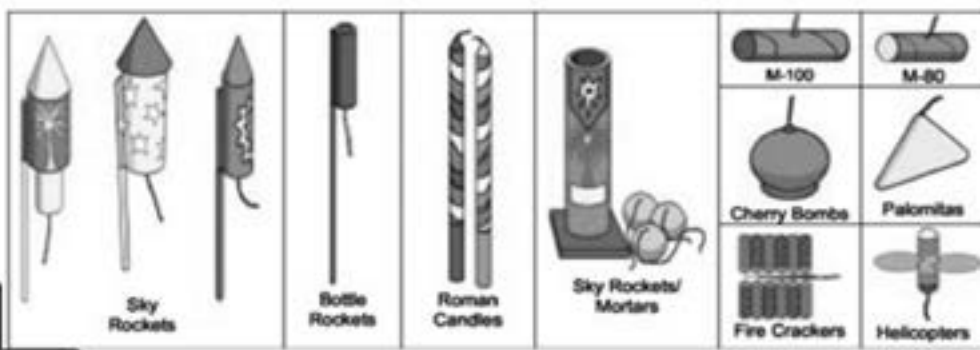

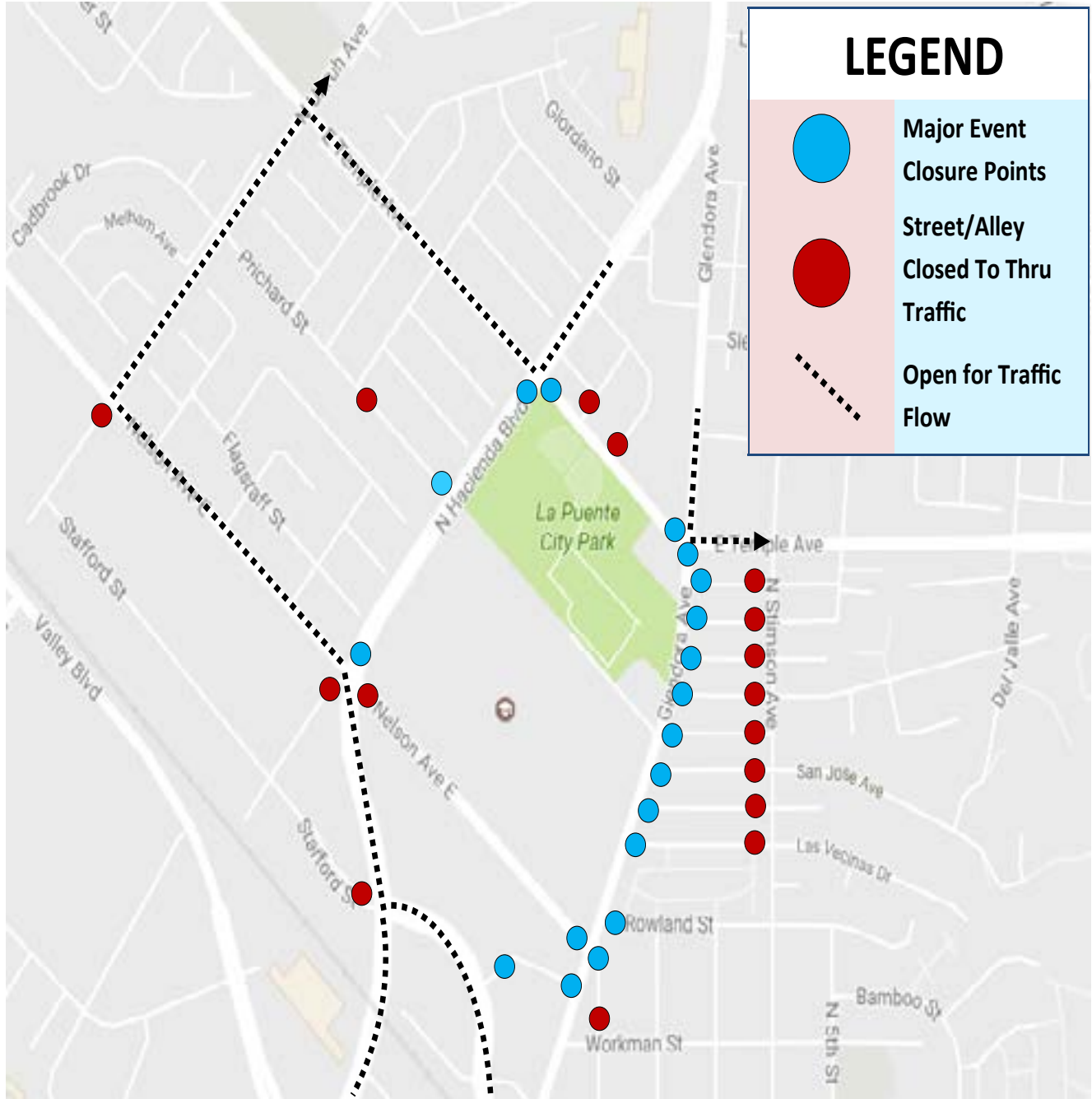
