
When: Saturday, November 16, 2019 - 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM

Senior Citizen Discount & Eligibility

Did you know that if you're age 65 years or older and Head of Household, you can qualify for a Senior Discount on your next trash bill? Valley Vista Services provides up to a 35% discount for seniors who bring in a copy of their valid California driver's license or identification card along with a current utility bill proving head of household. If you meet these requirements, stop by and submit a Senior Citizen's Discount application in person, or simply download it at https://www.valleyvistaservices.com/residential/walnut/. Once you've filled it out you can mail it into our office along with copies of all the required documents to 17445 E. Railroad St. in City of Industry.

Californians throw away nearly 6 million tons of food scraps or food waste each year. In order for



First Thing's First: What is Organic Waste?

Very simply, organic waste is anything that was once alive.

Organic Waste includes:

- ✓ Fruits / Vegetables
- Bakery items
- ✓ Meat, poultry, and seafood (including bones and shells)
- Eggs and paper egg cartons
- ✓ Dairy products
- ☑ Coffee grounds (including paper filters)
- ✓ Tea bags

Holiday "Treecycling"

Don't let your tree go to waste this holiday season! Make an impact on the environment by using V.V.S.'s free Holiday Tree Recycling Program for Walnut residents. Valley Vista Services will collect holiday trees placed curbside on your regularly scheduled trash day for two (2) weeks following December 26, 2019. Trees must be stripped of all ornaments, garland, tinsel, flocking and stands. After this service has ended, trees must be cut down to fit into your regular 96-gallon green waste container (with the lid closed). Holiday Schedule

Trash pickup will be delayed by one day if your regular collection day falls on or after the following holidays:

- Thursday, November 28th, 2019 Thanksgiving Day
- Wednesday, December 25th, 2019 Christmas Day
- Wednesday, January 1st, 2020 New Year's Day

If your regular collection days falls on a weekend, pickup will be made up on the prior Friday or following Monday.
