## Recycling & Disposal of Used Oil

Did you know that used motor oil can be recycled, cleaned, and used again and again? Motor oil should NEVER be poured onto the ground or into storm drains, or tossed into trash cans (even if in a sealed container) as it can contaminate and pollute the soil, groundwater, streams, and rivers.

When you take your used oil to a certified center for recycling, you are conserving a valuable resource while protecting the environment. Certified used oil collection centers will take up to 5 gallons of used motor oil and will pay you 40 cents per gallon.

Used motor should not be mixed with any other fluids such as antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, or water as it causes contamination and will not be accepted. # Holiday "Treecycling"

Make an impact on the environment this holiday season by using V.V.S.'s free Holiday Tree Recycling Program. VVSOC will collect and recycle holiday trees placed curbside on your regularly scheduled trash day from December 26, 2019 through



January 18, 2020. Trees must be cut into lengths no longer than 6 feet and stripped of all ornaments, garland, tinsel, flocking and stands. After this service has ended, trees must be cut down to fit into your regular 96-gallon green waste container (with the lid closed). Trash pickup will be delayed by one day if your regular collection day falls on or after the following holidays:

- Thursday, November 28th, 2019 Thanksgiving Day
- Wednesday, December 25th, 2019 Christmas Day
- Wednesday, January 1st, 2020 New Year's Day

If your collection days falls on a weekend, pickup will be made up on the prior Friday or following Monday.
