FREE HHW/E-Waste **Collection Event**

Los Angeles County Public Works is hosting a FREE one-day, drive-through collection event of HHW and electronic waste (e-waste) in the city of Diamond Bar.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is any unwanted product labeled with words such as "TOXIC", "CORROSIVE",

"POISON", "FLAMMABLE",

"IRRITANT". "DANGER".

"CAUTION" or

"WARNING", Common items include paint, used motor oil, household cleaning products, car



batteries, household batteries, fluorescent lights, mercury thermometers, and garden care products.

Electronic Waste (E-Waste) is any unwanted electronic device such as TVs, stereos, electronic games, microwaves, computers, and some small household appliances.

These items contain harmful chemicals, such as lead and mercury that can pollute the soil and groundwater and should NEVER be thrown away in the trash, poured down the sink drain or poured into storm drains. Safely dispose of these materials at the next HHW/E-Waste Collection Event happening:

> Saturday, March 14, 2020 9:00 am - 3:00 pm **Location: Gateway Corporate Center** (1300 block of Bridge Gate Drive)

HOW TO PREPARE:

- · Pack HHW in cardboard boxes to avoid spillage during transport. Be prepared to leave your containers and boxes at the site.
- Keep items in their original containers. Do not mix products.
- Put like chemicals together. Separate unlike chemicals.
- Label materials that are not in their original containers.
- Make sure containers are not leaking and lids are tightly sealed.
- Put your boxes in your car trunk, away from passengers during transport. Remove all other items from the trunk.
- At the event, trained personnel will ask you to remain in your car while they remove the HHW from your trunk.

*Please note that there is a limit of 15 gallons or 125 pounds of household hazardous waste per trip. For more information about collection events or sustainability programs to help businesses and residents of LA County, please call (888) CLEAN-LA or visit www.CleanLA.com.

Recycling Mandates AB 341 & AB 1826

Are you meeting the current state recycling mandate requirements? California's passage of Assembly Bills 341 and 1826 have set forth new standards when it comes to recycling for businesses and multi-family complexes. Currently under AB 341 (Mandatory Commercial Recycling Law), businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of waste weekly and multifamily properties of 5 units or more are required to arrange for recycling services. Under AB 1826 (Mandatory Organics **Recycling Law**), businesses and multi-family complexes must start recycling organic waste if they generate 4 or more cubic yards of solid waste and/or organic waste per week.

Organic waste recycling includes recycling of the following types of material:

- Food Waste
- Non-Hazardous Wood Waste
- Green Waste
- Landscape & Pruning Waste
- Food-Soiled Paper*

*Food-soiled paper includes items such as wax-coated food containers and soiled napkins mixed with food waste. Food-soiled paper does not include paper products with a plastic coating, e.g. paper cups with a polyethylene coating.
