Bulky Item Collection

VVS will provide three times per year, a four (4)-item On-Call Bulky Item Collection Service to residents at no additional charge. Bulky items are any items that are too large to fit into the standard collection cart like refrigerators, couches, and other electronic devices banned from the landfills called E-waste. Some acceptable items to have picked are:

Tables
Mattresses
Couches
Chairs
Carpet

Washers
Dryers
Refrigerators
Stoves
Water heaters

Game consoles
DVD players
Televisions
Computers
Monitors

Each resident must schedule their Bulky Item Pickup in advance to have items collected on the next regularly scheduled bulky pickup day, which is on *Mondays and Thursdays*. Please do not leave items out for collection without calling to schedule a pick-up and receiving confirmation. **Schedule a bulky item pickup today by calling our Customer Service Department at (800) 442-6454, placing your request via email at vvsbulky@myvvs.com or by submitting it directly at <https://www.valleyvistaservices.com/bulky-item/>.** Requests must include the account holder's Name, Address, Account Number and Phone Number, along with a list of the items to be picked up and quantity of each item.

Recycle Kitchen Waste While Feeding Your Garden

Eliminating food waste through composting is one of the simplest ways you can make a positive impact on the environment.

It's also the fifth tier of the EPA's Food Recovery Hierarchy. Instead of tossing your food scraps into the trash, simply add them to your compost bin. This can either be



done outdoors in the backyard or indoors depending if you have a smaller space and can be accomplished with a store-bought or do-it-yourself compost bin. Just make sure to turn the mix of soil and food scraps frequently. Once everything is decomposed evenly, you can use the composted soil to grow healthy houseplants, landscaping, or even your own veggie garden! **For more tips on how to start composting at home, go to**
