Recycle Kitchen Waste While Feeding Your Garden

Eliminating food waste through composting is one of the simplest ways you can make a positive impact on the environment. It's also the fifth tier of the EPA's Food



Recovery Hierarchy.
Instead of tossing your food scraps into the trash, simply add them to your compost bin.
This can either be done outdoors in the backyard or indoors depending if you have a smaller space and can be accomplished with a store-bought or do-it-yourself compost

bin. Just make sure to turn the mix of soil and food scraps frequently. Once everything is decomposed evenly, you can use the composted soil to grow healthy houseplants, landscaping, or even your own veggie garden! Used Oil Recycling

Every drop counts! When you take your used oil for recycling to a CalRecycle Certified Collection Center, you

are conserving a valuable resource while protecting the environment. Certified collection centers will accept up to 5 gallons of uncontaminated used oil from the public absolutely FREE during normal business hours. Some centers are also now accepting used oil filters. Be sure to call ahead to find out if the center you are visiting accepts filters for recycling.

Be Smart with Sharps

"Sharps" is a medical term for devices with sharp points or edges that can puncture or cut skin. Some examples include items such as needles, syringes, lancets and auto-injectors like epinephrine and insulin pens. VVSOC offers FREE, safe and convenient SHARPS collection and disposal services.



Twice per year, residents may request SHARPS containers for storing and mailing at no additional charge. Upon request, residents will receive an empty SHARPS container, pre-paid postage and disposal kit. This service is completely safe and confidential. To obtain a free SHARPS Mail-Back Kit, please call (714) 380-5450.
