Save the Food!

40% of all food in America is wasted, and there are more than 450,000 people at risk of going hungry each month in Orange County alone. California is taking huge steps to divert compostable materials, such as food waste, away from the landfills in an effort to combat climate pollution, and address the problem of food insecurity by recovering edible food from the waste stream.

Beginning January 1, 2022, California's SB 1383 will go into effect and will require all organics and food waste

generators to participate in organics waste recycling and food waste diversion programs. VVSOC will arrange for the collection and recycling of



residential organics waste beginning next year, but there are steps residents can start taking now to manage food waste more thoughtfully. **SaveTheFood.com** provides free resources to help get you started:

The Guest-imator

An interactive dinner party calculator that estimates how much food you need to keep guests happy and healthy.

A digital tool to create meal plans and perfectlyportioned shopping lists that help you kick food waste to the curb.

Used Oil Recycling

Every drop counts! The next time you do an oil change, take your used oil to one of the many CalRecycle Certified Used Oil Collection Centers throughout Orange County. Local auto parts stores and service centers such as AutoZone, O'Reilly Auto Parts, Pep Boys, Jiffy Lube, Valvoline Instant Oil Change and over 200 other businesses in Orange County are ready to serve you. All Certified Centers will accept USED OIL up to 5 gallons of uncontaminated used oil from the public absolutely FREE during normal business hours. Be sure to call ahead to find out if the center you are visiting also accepts filters for recycling. There is no I.D. or paperwork required to participate. Battery Disposal

Never throw away old batteries in the trash or in recycling carts, as they contain harmful chemicals to

the environment and pose a serious risk of fire. This includes AAA, AA, C, D, button cell, 9-volt, and all others, both rechargeable and single use. VVSOC offers a FREE curbside battery-recycling

program for the safe disposal of everyday use batteries. Simply seal the batteries in a clear plastic bag and place them on top of your blue recycling cart on your scheduled collection day. If you have any questions about this program, please call us at (714) 380-5450.
