'Tis the season to clear out the old and make room for the new! Here are some tips to help you accomplish all your spring cleaning goals:

Don't trash it, donate it - Instead of tossing out old furniture, appliances still in working condition, or gently used clothes and equipment, donate these items to your local secondhand store where they can have a second chance at life. This is helpful to others, and it benefits the community by helping to minimize materials headed to the landfill. Donate unwanted items to:

Multi-Family Food Recycling Coming Soon!

Valley Vista Services has officially begun to rollout the new **Food Waste Recycling Program** in City of Cypress. This is in accordance with **California State Law SB 1383**, which requires the recycling of all food waste generated by residential, commercial, and multi-family properties.

Senate Bill 1383 was instated in an effort to help reduce the release of harmful greenhouse gases, such as methane, which significantly harm the environment and contribute to climate change. With the implementation of food recycling in our local community, we can be part of the solution to combat climate change by participating in a closed food loop system. To understand where your food scraps go after they're collected, take a closer look at the graphic below:



By recovering organic materials, such as food and green waste, from the waste stream and diverting it into various organic waste processing methods, this waste is transformed into useful byproducts that benefit our environment. The organic waste collected goes from being a super pollutant, to being developed into renewable energies as well as soil amendments, such as mulch and compost, that are used to help grow more food locally. This is why having a closed food loop system helps to achieve a **zero-waste future!**
