**No Plastic Bags,**  
Place recyclables directly in your cart

Place all food in a clear or transparent plastic bag, tied securely, then place in the organics cart

Small Branches & Untreated Wood

Food Soiled Napkins (in small quantities)



**No Dirt or Rocks**



**No Palm Fronds**
