Backyard Service

Valley Vista Services will provide backyard service for residential waste collection.

Containers

Continue using your current barrels. VVS will service your existing containers.

What Goes Where:

Trash Barrel (Mixed Waste & Recyclables)

Place all trash and recyclables together in your designated cart. Valley Vista Services will collect the materials as mixed waste and separate recyclables during our post-collection sorting process.

Organics Barrel (Green Waste & Food Waste)

Place organic materials, such as green waste and bagged food waste, into your designated organics container to ensure proper recycling and environmentally responsible disposal.

Bulky Item Pickups

Residents may schedule up to two (2) on-call bulky item collections per year, at no extra charge. Each pickup allows for up to ten (10) bulky items.

Holiday Schedule

Valley Vista Services observes the following holidays. If a holiday falls on or before your regular collection day, service will be delayed by one day that week only. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay in service.

Holiday Tree Collection

VVS will collect holiday trees and greenery for three (3) full weeks from December 26 through January 15 of each year.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection

Los Angeles County and the Sanitation Districts sponsor weekly Household Hazardous and Electronic Waste (HHW/E-Waste) disposal events throughout the county. These free, one-day events provide residents with a safe and legal way to dispose of household chemicals and electronics that cannot go in the regular trash.

Accepted items include:

- Motor oil, oil filters, brake fluid
- Used antifreeze
- Paint, paint thinner, turpentine
- Cleaners containing acid or lye
 CRTs, TVs, electronics
- · Pesticides or herbicides
- Household or car batteries
- Pool chemicals
- Mercury thermometers or thermostats
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Unwanted or expired prescription medications
- Used needles or sharps (must be in a sharps container or sturdy box labeled "SHARPS")
