# Preventing Garbage Truck Fires: Safe Disposal of Hazardous Materials

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes items with toxic, corrosive, or flammable ingredients. Improper disposal can cause trash truck fires and environmental harm.

**Never throw away lithium-ion batteries** - they're a major fire risk!



#### Common Uses for Lithium-Ion Batteries:

- Smartphones, laptops, and tablets
- Electric vehicles (EVs)
- Power tools
- E-bikes and scooters
- Solar energy storage systems

#### **Proper Disposal Options:**

Take your HHW, including lithium-ion batteries and electronics, to a local collection center:

**Cypress Residents:** Dispose of small household batteries (AA, AAA, etc.) by placing them in a clear ziplock bag on top of your blue recycling cart. Ensure they are visible for curbside pickup.

## **Holiday Tree Recycling**

Valley Vista Services will collect and recycle holiday trees placed curbside on your regularly scheduled collection day from December 26, 2025 through the second week of January FREE. Please follow these guidelines in preparation for recycling your trees.



Remove all tree stands, lights, ornaments, tinsel and garland.



No flocked trees.



Trees must be cut into lengths no longer

After this free seasonal service has ended, holiday trees and other foliage must be cut down to fit into the standard 96-gallon green waste container (with the lid closed). If you have any questions, please contact us at valleyvistaservices.com/contact-us.

# **Quick Fall Waste Disposal Tips**



#### **Leaf & Yard Waste:**

Raking leaves and trimming branches is a fall tradition. Toss leaves, grass clippings, and small branches into the green waste cart.



#### **Pumpkins & Gourds:**

Compost whenever possible! Natural decorations like pumpkins, hay, and corn stalks can go in green waste cart or be composted at home.



#### **Requirements:**

Items must be no longer than 4 feet or heavier than 50 lbs — if heavier, please schedule a bulky item pickup.
