
How to Recycle Holiday Trees & Foliage

Holiday trees and foliage will be collected from December 26, 2025 through January 16, 2026.

Please Remember to:

- Remove all lights, ornaments, tinsel, and stands.
- Place tree/foliage at the curb next to your trash carts on your regular collection day, without blocking streets, alleys, or sidewalks.

Plastic trees/foliage are not recycled or accepted. Please call (800) 442-6454 to schedule a bulky item pickup for these items.

Timing Is Everything: Don't Let Your Trash Carts Break the Rules

In accordance with Los Angeles County Code, trash carts may only be placed at the curb after 5 p.m. the day before pickup and must be removed by 8 p.m. on collection day, or within two hours after pickup, whichever is later.

Spring Into Clean

Free Additional Services to Help You Declutter

Residential customers can schedule up to four free pickups per year for the items listed below.

- Bulky Items:** Unlimited number of small appliances, furniture, mattresses, etc per pickup.
- Excess Green Waste:** Maximum of ten bags/bundles per pickup. Bundles must be bound and less than four feet in length.
- Excess Trash:** Maximum of five bags or disposable containers per pickup. Loose trash will not be collected.
- Unwanted Clothing:** An unlimited number of bags of clothing per pickup.
- Construction Demolition:** Two containers/bundles under 70 pounds each, per pickup.

To arrange a pickup, call our Customer Service Department at (800) 442-6454 at least 24 hours in advance and place the items at the curb on your next regular pickup day.



Batteries Can Spark or Explode



Do not put in the trash or the recycling bin

Safely dispose of batteries at a participating LA County Library or a designated collection site. Take small personal electronics and other household hazardous waste (HHW) to a collection event nearby.

Keep Bike Lanes Clear

Residents with bike lanes in front of their homes should place carts on the sidewalk, not in the lanes, to ensure cyclists' safety. VVS drivers will retrieve and return carts to the sidewalk. Carts should also be placed back on your property after trash service.
