Green Goals: For a New Year

Kick off the new year by reinforcing your site's SB 1383 requirements with practical methods to minimize food waste after the holidays and throughout the year.



Employee Meals: Offer employees the opportunity to take home leftover holiday meals. This can help reduce food waste while providing a perk to your staff.



Donations to Food Banks: Donate surplus food to local food banks or shelters. Many organizations accept non-perishable and perishable items- this also helps feed those in need.



Sustainable Packaging: Make your holiday meals more sustainable by using eco-friendly packaging options. You can opt for recyclable or compostable containers to store your leftovers.



Educate Staff: Train kitchen and serving staff on food waste reduction techniques, responsible food handling, and proper food preparation and storage.



Inventory Management: Improve freshness and reduce waste by implementing first-in, first-out (FIFO) rotation and monitoring perishables closely.



Holiday Tree Recycling

Valley Vista Services will collect and recycle holiday trees free of charge upon request from **December 26, 2025, through the second week of January**. Please follow the guidelines below to prepare your tree for recycling.

- Remove all tree stands, lights, ornaments, tinsel and garland.
- No flocked trees.
- Trees must be cut into lengths no longer than 6 feet.
- Place trees near your trash enclosure for pickup.

To schedule a pickup, please call **(800) 442-6465**. After this free seasonal service has ended, holiday trees and other foliage must be cut down to fit into the standard green waste container, with the lid fully closed. Disposing of Hazardous Waste

Household Hazardous Waste includes products with toxic, reactive, or corrosive components. These items include, but are not limited to, batteries, household cleaners, paints, oils, and lightbulbs. Improper disposal of these chemicals can cause trash truck fires and create harmful environmental pollutants that pose risks to human health. Food Recovery Programs

CalRecycle estimates about 2.5 billion meals of edible food are landfilled each year, and SB 1383 requires food-related businesses to participate in food recovery programs.

Edible food is safe to eat but not sold due to appearance, freshness, age, size, or surplus, including prepackaged and prepared items.


