New Year, New Sorting Habits

Make sustainability your New Year's resolution! California is pushing forward to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and proper organic waste sorting makes a real impact. Keep food and yard waste out of the regular trash to help meet these goals.

What is Food Waste?

Food waste includes:

- Fruits
- Vegetables
- Meat
- Fish
- Bones
- Eggs
- Dairy
- Bread
- Grains
- Coffee Grounds & Filters

Place food waste in a **clear or transparent plastic bag** before placing it in the organic container. This helps keep food waste contained and ensures proper processing.

What is Yard Waste?

Yard waste consists of materials such as:

- Leaves
- Grass
- Flowers
- Small Branches & Twigs

Yard waste can be placed directly into the organic cart.

By properly sorting food and yard waste, residents and businesses can contribute to a cleaner, more sustainable future.

Food Recovery Programs

CalRecycle estimates that approximately 2.5 billion meals' worth of edible food is discarded into landfills annually. SB 1383 mandates that businesses involved in food **production, distribution, or service** participate in food recovery programs to address this issue.

Edible food refers to items that are safe for consumption but not sold due to appearance, freshness, age, size, or surplus quantity. This includes prepackaged and prepared foods.

Compost: Start a composting program for organic waste.

Recycle: Provide convenient recycling bins.



Reuse Materials: Repurpose boxes, packaging, and durable plastics.



Buy Smart: Choose products that are durable, repairable, and recyclable.
