Friendly Reminder: Correct Cart Placement



To ensure on-time collection service, please arrange your trash, recycling, and organics carts as follows:

- Place at the set-out site no earlier than 5 p.m. on the day before the scheduled collection, and place carts back on your property by 8 p.m. on the day of collection, or within two hours after collection, whichever is later.
- Set out carts with wheels against the curb. Place carts side by side, spaced about one (1) foot apart and at least three (3) feet from parked vehicles or other objects.
- Lids should fully close and remove any excess materials, if necessary.
- Ensure carts are not blocked as collection trucks require unobstructed access.
- Carts cannot block the normal movement of vehicles or pedestrians.

Disposing of Hot Coals



1. **Cool the coals completely.** Allow hot coals to sit inside the grill for at least 48 hours with the lid and vents closed. You can also soak them in water.
2. **Secure the cooled coals.** Once cooled, wrap the coals tightly in aluminum foil or place them in a metal container.
3. **Dispose of them safely.** Place the wrapped or contained coals inside your outdoor black trash cart.

The Responsible Path for Unused Paint

Leftover paint, while seemingly harmless, can have significant environmental implications if not disposed of correctly. You can also properly dispose of unused paint by attending a FREE temporary Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event.
